March 31, 23:59EDT - Racer Registration Deadline

Are you planning to race this year? More than 100 racers have registered so far! You'll need copies of your pilot certificate, medical certificate or BasicMed documents, and a government-issued photo ID. Have you registered as a racer but haven't finished your team registration? Don't forget to upload a photo showing the pilot on the left side and the copilot on the right, with a separate photo for teammates. *For best results, the photo should be 300 pixels by 300 pixels and not smaller than 200 megabytes.* The fee paid at team registration includes the entry fee, as well as the Start and Terminus fees. May 15 23:59EDT - Airplane Registration Deadline

Once you've registered as a team, the next step is to register your airplane. The complete online airplane registration form and complete AD list must be submitted before Airplane Registration Closing date. Email airplane@airraceclassic.org with questions.
